Distance	Plan	Description	1	
0.000		Depart from Ferrara , Piazza Savonarola. Go towards Piazza Castello through the arches and then onto Largo Castello along the edge of the moat.		
0.210		At the crossroads with Viale Cavour, turn left onto the cycle/pedestrian path on the left side of Viale Cavour.		
0.360		At the crossroads with Via Spadari, cross Viale Cavour, and continue along the service road on the opposite side, crossing the junctions with Via Ariosto and Via Cittadella.		
1.150		Go straight across the crossroads with Via Barriere and continue along the cycle lane to the right of Viale Po.		
1.250		Cross Viale Po and continue along the cycle lane to the left side of Viale Po. Railway station: after crossing Viale Po, go left along the cycle lane alongside Viale Costituzione.		
2.150		Go straight over the crossroads with Via del Lavoro and straight on along the cycle lane to the lefthand side of Via Modena.		
2.390		Go straight over the crossroads with Via Gulinelli and cross the cycle bridge over the Canale Boicelli, to continue straight on along the cycle lane to the lefthand side of Via Modena.		
3.710		TAKE CARE! At Mizzana, cross Via Modena and turn onto Cycle Route FE101 <i>Burana</i> , along the righthand side of the Canale Burana.		
5.090		A little after the subway beneath the motorway (highway), head to the left away from Via C. Diana, on the cycle/pedestrian path which shortly afterwards crosses the Canale Burana.

10.580		Cross Via Diamantina and carry straight on along the FE101 cycle/pedestrian path. DIVERSION: go to the right along Via Diamantina for the <i>Delizia Estense della Diamantina</i> (1.250 km).		
16.250		At the crossroads with Via Cavo Napoleonico go under the railway on the cycle track, then up the access ramp for the cycle bridge over the Cavo Napoleonico canal.		
17.180		At the crossroads with Via delle Rose turn left onto the road.		
17.400		Go straight on along Via Fermi (which becomes Via Borgo San Giovanni) towards Bondeno.		
17.510		Turn right, alongside the river Panaro on Via San Biagio (the SP19 main road), part of the FE20 Destra Po cycle route. CONNECTS TO: provincial route number 3		
17.720		Village of Ospitale . Go through the underpass beneath the railway and then straight on along Via San Biagio, staying at the bottom of the embankment.		
18.360		Cross over Via Madonna della Pioppa and go straight on and up onto the embankment of the river Panaro. DIVERSION: go right to the <i>Santuario Madonna della Pioppa</i> .		
18.920		Leave Ospitale. Bear left so as to stay on the river Panaro embankment road and the FE20 Destra Po cycle route.		
20.640		Continue to the left so as to stay on the Panaro embankment road and the FE20 <i>Destra Po</i> cycle route.		
24.010		Water works at the junction of the Cavo Napoleonico and the River Po. Go straight on along the road, and when across the Cavo Napoleonico, go left on the FE20 cycle route.		
29.000		At Ravalle , continue along the Po embankment (FE20 cycle route). For the rest area, come down off the embankment and go right along Via Robissa for 0,230 km.		
40.180		At Pontelagoscuro carry on along the Po embankment on Via Gino Bartali.		
40.960		OBLIGATORY DIVERSION TO THE DESTRA PO ROUTE: go right and down onto the cycle path to the righthand side of Via Padova (the SS16 road).

41.200		OBLIGATORY DIVERSION TO THE DESTRA PO ROUTE: at Pontelagoscuro, turn left onto Via della Ricostruzione.		
41.650		OBLIGATORY DIVERSION TO THE DESTRA PO ROUTE: pass the junction to the right with Via Nuova and go straight on along Via della Ricostruzione towards the subway under the railway.		
41.760		OBLIGATORY DIVERSION TO THE DESTRA PO ROUTE: after the railway underpass, keep left to climb back up onto the Po embankment on Via della Ricostruzione.		
42.560		Leave Via della Ricostruzione and go straight on along the FE20 cycle route. CONNECTS TO: city route number 1 to Ferrara on the FE202 cycle path (7.430 km).		
46.720		Turn right down off the embankment in the direction of Ferrara. CONNECTS TO: provincial route number 1		
46.870		At Francolino , go straight on and across the crossroads with Via del Cristo / Via Fratelli Patracchini.		
47.200		At the junction with Via Zerbinata in Francolino, turn onto the FE203 cycle track on the left of Via dei Calzolari and carry on straight in the direction of Ferrara.		
47.920		Cross the junction with Via Pioppelle (to the left) and continue on the FE203 cycle track on the left side of Via dei Calzolari.		
48.440		Chiesa di San Marco Evangelista. Cross the junction with Via Pianelle (to the left) and continue on the FE203 cycle track on the left side of Via dei Calzolari.		
49.040		Cross Via Fossa Lavezzola and Via dei Calzolari to carry on along the FE203 cycle track on the right side of Via dei Calzolari.		
51.540		Cross Via dei Calzolari and carry on along the FE203 cycle track on the left side of Via dei Calzolari.		
52.130		Cross the junction with Via dei Gladioli (to the left) and continue on the FE203 cycle track on the left side of Via dei Calzolari.		
52.250		Cross the junction with Via Conca and continue on the FE203 cycle track on the left side of Via dei Calzolari.

52.970		Cross Via dei Calzolari and carry on along the FE203 cycle track following the signs for the centre of Ferrara.		
53.690		Turn left following the signs for the centre of the city and stay on the FE202 cycle track by the side of the CUS sports centre.		
53.910		Turn right following the signs for the city centre and stay on the FE202 cycle track between the CUS and the canal.		
54.340 54.570 ▶		Cross the access road to the public swimming pool and carry straight on along the FE202 cycle track alongside the Parco Urbano Giorgio Bassani .		
54.900		Turn left, cross Via Bacchelli and carry straight on along the cycle track towards the opening in the walls.		
55.030		Immediately through the walls, the cycle path ends: turn left along Via Orlando Furioso.		
55.310		At the end of Via Orlando Furioso turn left onto Corso Ercole I d'Este, away from the walls and towards the city centre.		
55.840		Go over the crossroads with Via Guarini / Via Arianuova to carry straight on along Corso Ercole I d'Este.		
56.090		Palazzo dei Diamanti . Go over the crossroads with Via Porta Po / Corso Biagio Rossetti to carry straight on along Corso Ercole I d'Este.		
56.570		When you reach the Castello Estense , turn left alongside the moat.		
56.690		Turn right along Corso Martiri della Libertà, carry on alongside the moat of the Castello Estense .		
56.830		Arrive: Ferrara, Piazza Savonarola. For the railway station (1.47 km) go through the arches and onto Piazza Repubblica (to your right, the entrance to the courtyard of the castle and Tourist Information Office), and then Via Garibaldi, Via Cassoli, Piazzale della Castellina, Piazzale Stazione.
